There is a delightful colour illustration to accompany Stephen Spender's '*Chalk Blue*' poem by Gordon Beningfield in '*Poems of the Countryside*', as well as pictures of Meadow Browns, Small Tortoiseshells and Red Admirals to complement other poems.

Butterfly Conservation President Gordon Beningfield himself has produced illustrations of many British species of butterfly and these can be found with an accompanying text in his work 'Beningfield's Butterflies'.

A more recent work which includes illustrations of butterflies amongst those of other wildlife, as well as some very interesting text, is '*F. W. Frowhawk: His Life and Work*' by Dr J. Chatfield.

There are also black and white drawings of butterflies in the works of B.B.

'Bright Wings of Summer, by David Measures is also recommended.

Five paintings to be found in the National Gallery (of which postcards are available) are: '*Long Grass with Butterflies*' by Van Gogh; '*The Painter's Daughter catching a Butterfly*' (unfinished) by Gainsborough; and the following three which are particularly recommended: '*Flowers in a Terracotta Vase*' by Jan van Hujsum; and two paintings by Paulus Theodorus van Brussel entitled '*Flowers in a Vase*'.

Music

Three compositions which might be useful in this difficult field are: '*Papillons*' by Schumann; '*Le Papillon Et La Fleur*', an arrangement for piano and voice of a poem by Victor Hugo by Gabriel Fauré; finally, a particular favourite, '*The Red Admiral Butterfly (Slip Jig)*' by James Galway and the Chieftains.
