

23. How about a Butterfly calendar? Something to treasure all year round.
24. Other types of mobile could be a life-cycle or a food chain. See p. 22
25. Using coloured paper to illustrate the scales on the wings of a butterfly, a whole group could make a wall frieze.
26. Some schools may have the facilities to do some screen printing, spray painting or block printing using the idea of butterflies.
27. Shoe boxes can be used to make a very effective diorama of a woodland scene.
28. One idea that requires some research could be a butterfly wheel chart, illustrating at what stage in its life cycle a butterfly is in at any time of the year.
29. Pupils will enjoy trying to make butterflies out of plasticine, play-doh clay or even papier-maché.
30. If a nature walk is possible, pupils could construct a frieze to illustrate changing habitats. This could also apply to the journey to school or regular walks taken by pupils. This activity may well relate to map-work exercises.
31. N.B. The "Butterfly Race" game (page 25) could easily be developed. Certainly life could be more hazardous if there was bad weather, more predators or even collectors around! This game could be developed into a type of "Ludo".
32. The teacher and pupils could well combine to make a butterfly folder or workbook to be used as a reference or record of activity.
33. Most of the above ideas could be adapted for caterpillars. How about making a model of a nettle patch with hairy caterpillars, perhaps using pipe cleaners.
34. Egg boxes can easily be adapted to make caterpillars and can then be painted. For antennae use match sticks. Especially good are egg trays rather than just egg boxes.
35. A teacher may even feel brave enough to try face painting!
36. In a craft lesson, kites could be made with pictures of butterflies on them.
