The role of the County Recorder



Purpose of the County Recorder

- Act as the focal point for recording in their area, which will normally be individual counties, but may sometimes be larger areas
- Promote butterfly and/or moth recording and conservation in their area
- Act as intermediaries between many thousand recorders and the central recording schemes
- Ensure the quality of butterfly and moth records submitted to the Butterflies for the New Millennium (BNM) and the National Moth Recording Scheme (NMRS)

What do County Recorders do?

- Local experts
- Verify records from the recording community
- Encourage recording & promote schemes
- Provide feedback to recorders
- Promote butterflies and moths
- Collate and manage local datasets in accordance with GDPR and BCs data police
- Local reporting to BC Branches, LERCs and other local groups
- Submit records to NMRS & BNM target date 31st March, although data are accepted year round



.....and often lots more...!

Additional optional duties

- Provide encouragement, information, support and feedback to local recorders (e.g., through direct communication, writing newsletters, reports and articles, web pages, meetings etc.)
- Liaise with relevant local groups (e.g., natural history societies, biological records centres etc.)
- Engage with local communities, landowners and the wider public
- Promote lepidoptera recording by providing comments for local media on request
- Provide lepidoptera data and/or interpretation of data to users such as local and regional biodiversity partnerships, biological records centres and other interested partners







- Personal computer password protected with up-to-date antivirus software and internet connection
- Able to represent Butterfly Conservation and its values
